How Can PIH Help My Family?

- One-on-one support
- Find local resources for food, clothing, housing, etc.
- Assist your family in finding free or low cost activities
- Focus on your total child's physical and behavioral well-being
- Access to support 24/7
- Work with all of your providers to ensure collaboration
- Educational information to support you in your caregiver role
- Assistance addressing school related needs by attending meetings
- Connect your family to medical providers

Your family will be assigned a care team consisting of:

- A Care Coordinator, who can locate and link your family to services and resources.
- A Nurse Coordinator that can answer your medical questions and assist you in navigating the healthcare system.
- A Family Support Specialist who provides 1-1 support, a listening ear, and can empower you to advocate for your child.



Eligibility requirements to receive PIH services:

- Your child must be under the age of 18
- Your child must have a qualifying mental health diagnosis
- AND your child must have Medicaid (Amerigroup, Iowa Total Care, IME, or Molina)
