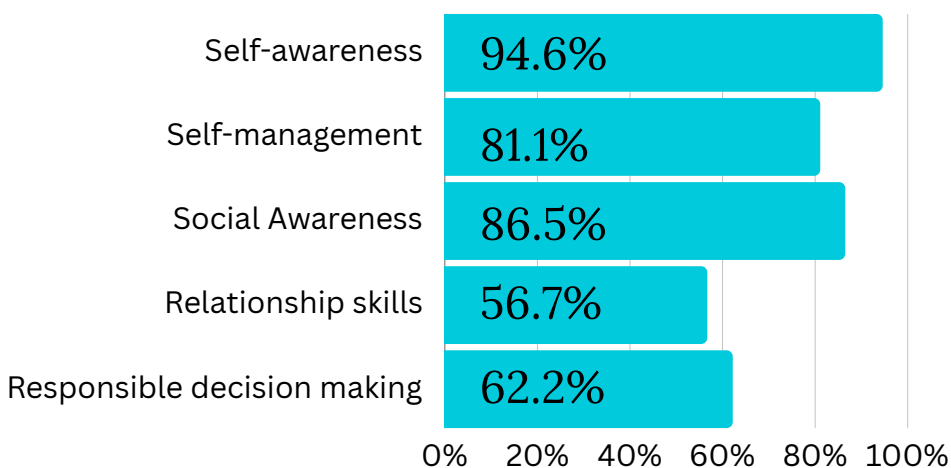
Roosevelt & McKinley Middle Schools, 69 youth served, 6-8 grade youth

When asked about Social Emotional Skill Development, youth responded positively at the following rates:

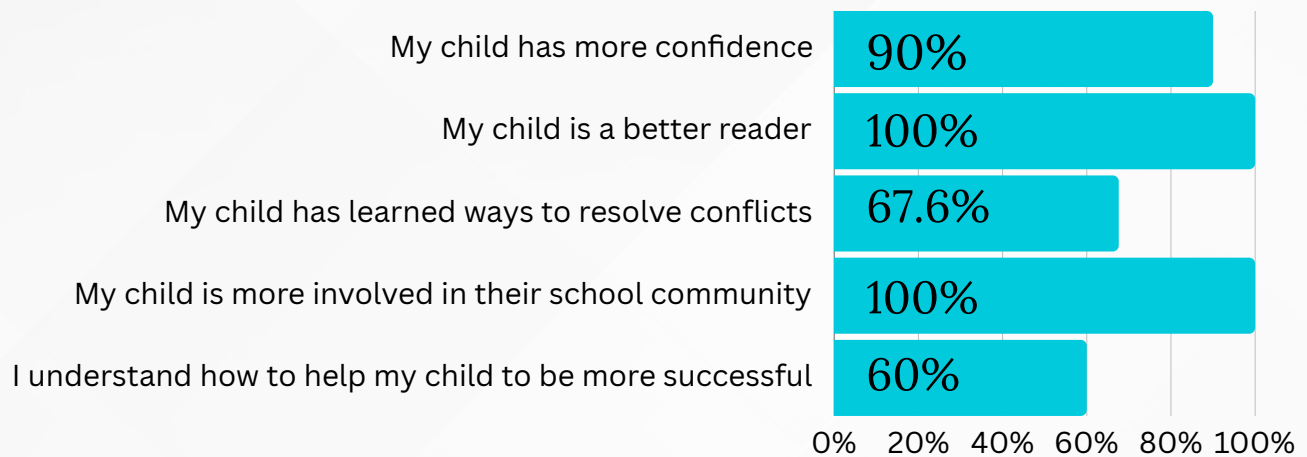

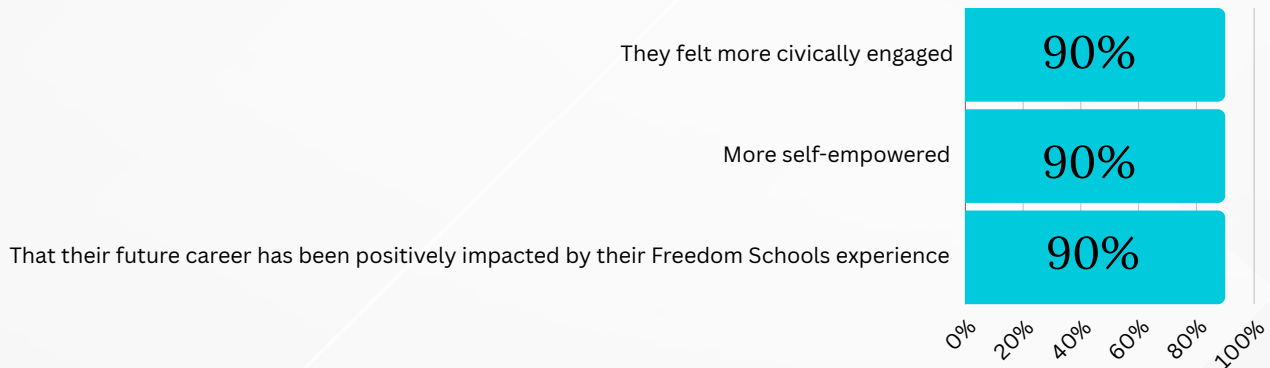
Freedom Schools Scholars improved their reading score by an average of 1 year and 3 months.
